

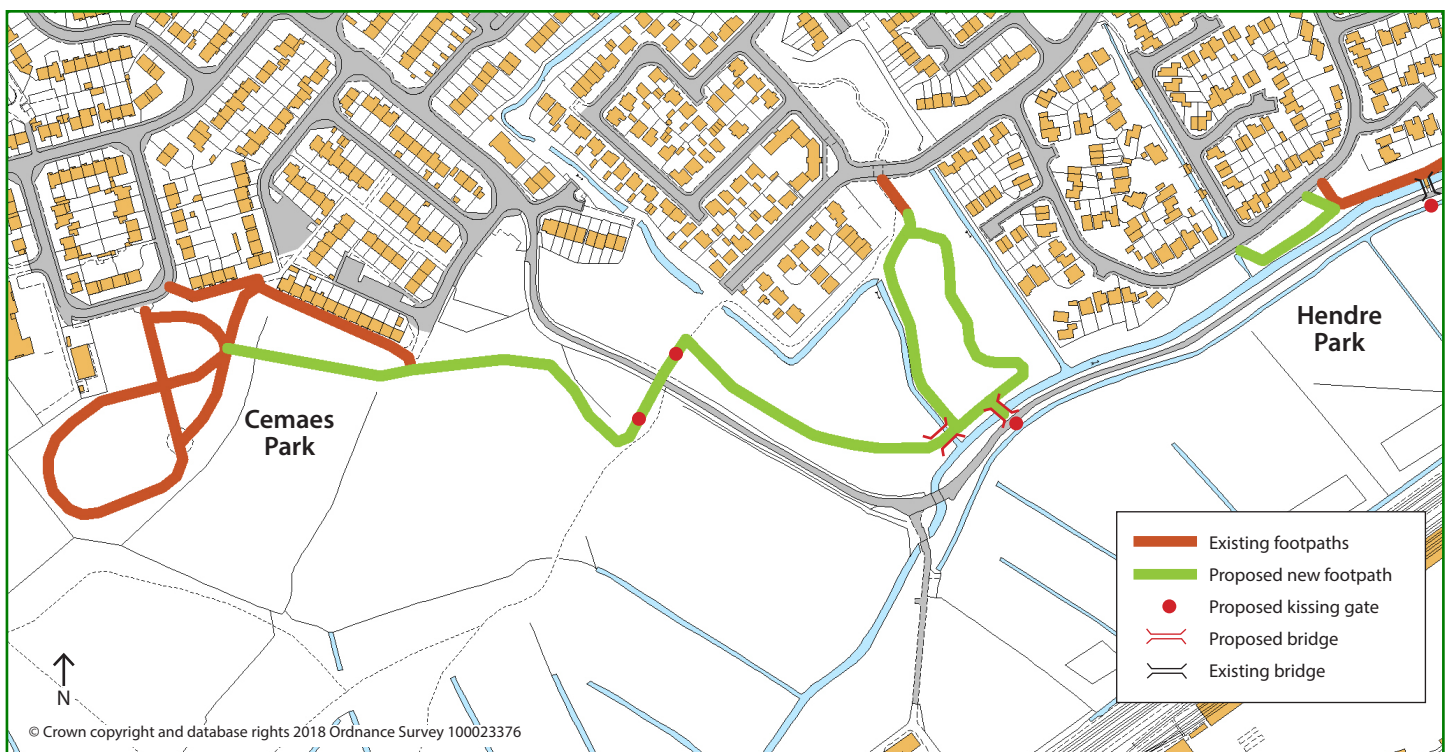
We write to provide you with an update to proposals published in December, to create an improved footpath link between Hendre Park and Cemaes Park.

Our public information exercise was successful in gathering a wide range of comments and opinions regarding the original proposal - our thanks to all those who responded. Whilst there was appreciation for the provision of the footpath link between the two locations there was also concern about the proposal's proximity to housing and the possible increase in the misuse of motor cycles in the area. Assisted by the feedback we received, we have carefully considered how this scheme may be taken forward in such a way that takes account of the views of local people, and in particular those who would be most directly affected.

The plan below shows our alternative route which moves the footpath away from the rear of properties on Matthysens Way and Harrison Drive, but continues to provide a link between Hendre Park and Cemaes Park. Kissing gates will be installed at entrance points on the route in order to deter motorcycles.

We will also look to include within the scheme, improvements to pedestrian access at the car park entrance to Hendre Park, necessary repairs to existing footpaths leading into Hendre Park and footpath improvements within Cemaes Park.
